The problem of the study is to reveal how the children as victims of war is reflected in Bahman Ghobadi's *Turtles Can Fly* Movie . The objectives of the study are to analyze the structural elements of the movie and to analyze the movie based on the sociological perspective.

This study employs the qualitative method. The object of the study is *Turtles Can Fly* movie directed by Bahman Ghobadi. The data sources are divided into two, namely primary data source and secondary data source. The primary data source is the movie itself and the secondary data are script text and some references related to the research. The techniques of data collection are note-taking and image-capturing. The results of the research shows the following conclusions.
