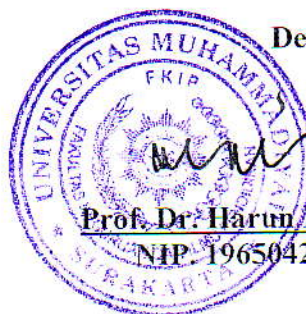

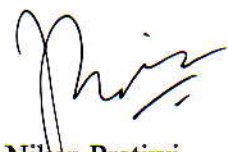

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SUMMARY

This major problem of this study is about violation of women's right reflected in Carmen bin Ladin's *Inside the Kingdom* memoir. The objective of this study is to analyze the novel based on its structural elements and to analyze the novel based on the feminist analysis.

In analyzing *Inside the Kingdom* memoir, the writer uses qualitative method and feminist approach. The object of the study is Carmen bin Ladin's *Inside the Kingdom* memoir which was published on July, 2004, in the United States of America by arrangement with Warner Books, Time Warner Book Group New York, and consists of more than 200 pages. The data sources consist of primary data and secondary data sources.
