CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Study

Romantic relationship in married life is the desire of everyone, especially for those who are already or will through the life of the household, because basically romantic relationship is the foundation of a harmonious family's formation. However, not everyone can embody the desire. There are many factors that affect the absence of romantic relationship in married life, for example the busyness of a husband or wife in their work so they rarely meet and spend time with their family. In 1973, Sparks with his family moved from Los Angeles to Grand Island, Nebraska for one year, then, they moved to Fair Oaks, California on December 1, 1974. At the same time, Sparks survived an elementary school and he allowed to continue up the educational ladder. When Sparks fourteen years old, his brain was kicked, and finally he ended up his study as the valedictorian. Sparks come back to Los Angeles to continue his study in Senior High School. At the same time, he holds a number of school records and he received a full track scholarship in the University Of Notre Dame. After receiving a full scholarship, he got injured and breaking Notre Dame record. He spent the rest of the year icing on his Achilles tendon. Looking of his condition, his mother asked him to do something like writing a book, in order to make Sparks moved from his condition and not just to pout. Because of his mother's pressure, he starts to writes. The Passing, become his first novel that written by him but it was never published. In March, 1988, he met a beautiful girl named Cathy. Cathy is a young girl from New Hampshire and she was his first love. In 1989, they were married and have two children named Miles Andrew and Ryan Cody. During their marriage, there are many things that inspired Sparks to write a novel about love, which one of his inspirations comes from his wife's grandparents. At that time, he wants write a novel which a love story become the main topic on it. He would create a sense of tragedy necessary for a quality love story in his novel. Sparks also thought about a plot of his story almost two months before writing the novel. He typed out 80.000 words and cut it by 28.000 words. Finally, in January 1995 he finished writes a novel entitled *The Notebook*.

The Notebook is a romantic novel first published in 1996. Nicholas Sparks poured the romantic relationship as the main theme on his novel. By using the novel, he wants to take the readers to enter into the world of his novel. So, they can understand what the story is. He writes it systematically, it makes the readers easy to grasp the content of this novel which the content of this novel is about the everlasting power of "true love". In *The Notebook*

novel, Sparks also shows the great of faithfulness in love. It gives more inspirations for people, especially for teenagers for having relationship.

The Notebook is made by Nicholas Sparks based on true story. This novel inspired from his wife's grandparents who have rare and great relationship which everlasting even they often faced many problems and obstacles in their life. Sparks thought about a plot of this story almost two months before writing this novel. He would create a sense of tragedy necessary for a quality love story in this novel. He typed out 80.000 words and cut it by 28.000 words, but finally in January 1995 he finished writes this book. The Notebook novel itself consists of 12 chapters and 498 pages inside it. This novel told on two levels, the first is the story of a couple named Noah Calhoun and Allie Hamilton. The first level, The Notebook tells how Noah and Allie met, fell in love, lost each other, and then finally found each other again. The second is the present day when Noah and Allie have grown old and live together. The end of their love is tragically changed by Allie's Alzheimer's diagnosis, but they have no power over their love.

The Notebook is a fascinating novel. There are three reasons why the researcher is interested to study this novel. First, this novel tells about the story of first love, which turns into true love. The novel conveys about how Noah as the major character can maintain of his first love, even there are many obstacles that must be faced by him. From the first time Noah and Allie met, Allie's mother did not agree with their relationship because the difference social class between them, then Allie engaged to Lon, and the last Allie was suffering Alzheimer's. Noah never goes away from Allie and kept waiting for her until she was back to him again. Second, the setting of place in The Notebook novel takes place in a small southern town. That is New Bern, North Carolina. The researcher concerns with that town because it is a small town that can make us feel like we can go back to the quiet and romantic period. The last is The Notebook has some moral message inside its story. One of the messages is this story can makes the readers feel what the main characters feel, so they can build an empathy with others. This story

also gives the lessons for everyone who reads, that if we want to get or achieved something, we should work hard and make an effort, because the great thing does not come easily.

In this research, the researcher analyzed the romantic relationship as seem in Nicholas Sparks's novel entitled *The Notebook*. The romantic relationship is interesting to be discussed because human being as a God's creature has a sense and consciousness of themselves, they have the desire to build happiness with someone else that is what encourages people to interact and build an intimate relationship with others. This is because basically romantic relationship can bring happiness to every human being.
