# KATNISS EVERDEEN'S INDEPENDENCE IN NOVEL THE HUNGER GAMES BY SUZANNE COLLINS (2008): A FEMINIST APPROACH

#### **Abstrak**

Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian tentang The Hunger Games oleh Suzanne Collins yang di lihat dari perspektif feminis. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk menemukan dan menjelaskan jenis-jenis kemandirian wanita yang di alami oleh Katniss Everdeen sebagai karakter utama wanita dan untuk mengungkapkan makna yang signifikan dari kemandirian Katniss. Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kualitatif yang menerapkan metode analisis isi. #### **Abstract**

This research is a study of Suzanne Collins's The Hunger Games viewed from feminist perspective. The objectives of the research are to find out and explain the kinds of women's independence by Katniss Everdeen as the main female character and to reveal the significant meaning of Katniss's independence. This research is a qualitative study applying content analysis method. The object of this research is a novel entitled The Hunger Games written by Suzanne Collins in 2008 and the data are sentences related to Katniss's independence found in the novel. The data analysis was conducted by classifying and categorizing the data to find the inferences. In order to gain reliability, the researcher read and reread the novel carefully and then recorded the data into a systematic framework based on the theory. The results of this indicate two points, the first point is kinds of Katniss's independence which is represent into four categories: 1) women's independence in society, 2) women's independence in education, 3) women's independence in work place, 4) women's independence are woman can gain their

independence, intelligent and courageous attitude. Katniss can win in The Hunger Games with Peeta melark because of her strategy. The analysis of Katniss's independence intends to distinguish between analyses of feminist in literature study feminist analysis in other research fields.

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

#### 3.1.4 Women's Independence in Economy

Women can control their own income. When women have economic power – defined as control of income and capital like land, livestock etc. they got more equality and control over their own lives.

"Say you are poor and starving as we were." (C1, P12)

#### 3.2 How survive to win

To be a winner is not easy. It needs hard work, strategy and never give up. In this games just has 2 choice. Kill or to be killed. The main character survive to win The Hunger Games can be seen in statement below:

"The heat is horrible, but worse than the heat is smoke, which threatens to suffocate me at any moment. I pull the top of my shirt up over my nose, grateful to find it soaked in sweat, and it offers a thin veil of protection. And I run, choking, my bag banging against my back, my face cut with branches that materialize from the gray haze without warning, because I know I am supposed to run." (C13, P165)

#### 3.3 Discussion

This research tried to describe the kinds of women's independence through feminist approach and the main character survive to win in novel The Hunger Games.

In this research from the novel by Suzanne Collin only retrieve data from chapter 1 until 25 for source data. There are five Women's independence used Feminist theory but the writer only found four kinds in chapter one until four namely: Women's independence in society in chapter 2, Women's independence education in chapter 3 until 4, Women's independence work place in chapter 1 and Women's independence economy in chapter 1 until 2.

The first is women's independence in society. Katniss everdeen as a main role in this novel has a critical role in her family. She replace her father and took over as head of family to save her family. Katniss become a volunteer in the hunger games when her sister's name out.

The fourth is women's independence in economy. Katniss is a poor women. District 12 is a poorest area. That's not surprised to saw many people starving and malnourished.

The way of Katniss Everdeen survive to win in The Hunger Games shown in chapter 12 until 25. She put a snares in the woods so she could eat and finally she got a good rabbit in chapter 12. She pull the top of her shirt up over her nose to protect her from a smoke of woods fires in chapter 13. Katniss cut the branch and make the nest fall to the ground in chapter 14. Katniss has a good idea to eat the poison berry and finally she and Peeta announced as a winner in chapter 25.

#### 4. CONCLUSION
