Meanwhile, according to Sarwono (1989: 14) the definition of hedonism is a self-concept, where one's lifestyle is lived in accordance with the understanding in his mind. For example, a sportsman, usually a healthy lifestyle is a principle of life and become their own pleasure. So that it can be concluded hedonism is a behavior to fulfill the pleasure of his life or body, can be in the form of material, movement, behavior, physical body and others - and try as much as possible to avoid pain and disappointment.

In this novel many events that reflect the attitude of hedonism in the community of the rich. Can be seen from the title of the novel, which hints about the lives of the rich. This novel tells the story of conflict due to the lifestyle of several wealthy families. The family was divided into Young Clans, T'Sien and Sang Clans. Edison Cheng bought a hundred million suit to go to the wedding of Aramitha and Collin. Next, the single party conducted by Aramitha and Collin. Aramitha invited all her female friends to go to the island. Aramitha provides 5-star lodging facilities, provides a place to shop for free fashion, which comes from international designers. Collin invited all his male friends to party on a luxury cruise ship and very complete facilities.

The next reason for the author is that there are many conflicts that are also accompanied by solutions, so that they can be used as learning. Like the conflict with the main character, Nicholas Young and Rachel Chu. Early in the introduction to the family, Rachel Chu was rejected by Nicholas Young's family, but finally Rachel was well received in the Nicholas Young family.

Astrid's problems with Michael Teo they want a divorce. But finally they realized that this problem was only a misunderstanding and selfishness. Examples of other problems are between Ah Ma with Eleanor Sung, Alistair Cheng with Kiity Pong, Edison Cheng with his family.

That is what underlies the author to examine the novel entitled Crazy Rich Asians written by Kevin Kwan in 2013.
