Albom graduated his education in Brandeis University Waltham - New Jersey as a novel author. He has produced a few novels such as *The Magic Strings of Frankie Presto; The Five People You Meet in Heaven, The Time Keeper, Have*

A Little Faith, For One More Day, The First Phone Call from Heaven. The Five People You Meet in Heaven Novel is one of the bestselling novel by Mitch Albom, the researcher interest to analysis because it has many moral value about lesson of life to being grateful. It shows on journey of life and afterlife of Eddie in heaven.

Eddie is a maintenance in Ruby Pier. It is an Amusement Park and fantastic attraction for all ages. Eddie has been a ride operator and mechanic for many years to help his father job. On his 83rd birthday he dies while trying to save a young girl. After death, he goes to heaven and meet the five person to explain his earthly life where help Eddie understand the different part and the unseen connections of his life. They will give him lesson of life and teach him to more being grateful.

The first person meet Eddie is Blue Man. He tells him how he was indirectly responsible for his death.
