DISSOCIATIVE IDENTITY DISORDER (DID) IN M.NIGHT SHYAMALAN'S MOVIE SPLIT (2017): PSYCHOANALYTIC PERSPECTIVE

Abstrak

Abstract

3.2.1 Conclusion from finding

3.2.3 The research related to previous studies

From the previous studies above, it can be conclude that it based on the same object, *Split* movie by M.Night Shyamalan. There are eight people who analyze about *Split* movie. They research about mental illness, Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID) and narrative structure of the movie. There is no people using psychoanalytic perspective. This research has a position as a complement to previous research.

4. CLOSING

The movie SPLIT tells about dissociative identity disorder or multiple identity disorder. The main character has suffered dissociative identity disorder because of past traumas. The author tries to discover the background of main character that causes dissociative

identity disorder, show the Dissociative Identity Disorder in Split by psychoanalytic perspective, and the reason why the director write this issue in the movie.

Based on the analysis, researcher finds the id and super ego. Those are: seven scene of id which shows all of the physical abuse which he only want fulfill his pleasure and one scene of super ego about the reason why the main character didn't kill the last girl, Casey, because he saw the girl's body which same like him that caused by physical abuse in the past. The reason why the director write this issue is because he wants people to aware and know the danger posed by this disease.
